## Web - cookies

Your consent is required for the use of cookies on our website in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (General Data Protection Regulation), the Law on the Implementation of the General Data Protection Regulation and the Electronic Communication Law.

Cookies are small data files that are stored by the web browser on your computer, tablet or mobile device used when you first visit the website. After the first visit, each time the web browser requests an identical page from the server, cookies are sent from the user account to the server. In this way, the server is able to identify and track the web browsers. Your visit to a website allows this website to recognise your computer or IP address if you revisit the website while a particular cookie is active, which ensures personalized user experience when visiting the same website.

The cookies we use on this website do not serve us to access your files or personal information stored on the computer from which you access our website and do not have the function of monitoring all user activities or capturing and saving the user's IP address, username and password, nor are they spam-related.

Our website uses the following cookies:

- Persistent cookies are cookies that are saved on your computer and are not deleted automatically when you quit your browser, unlike a session cookie, which is deleted when you quit your browser. They help websites remember your information and settings when you visit them in the future. These cookies stay on your computer until you delete them manually from your browser settings or your browser deletes them based on the duration period contained within the persistent cookie's file, which is for this website 1 (one) year.
- HTTP cookies or HTTPOnly cookies are cookies that tell the browser not to access the user's application and programme protocols.
- First party cookies are cookies stored by the domain (website) you are visiting directly.
  They may be permanent or temporary. Websites use these cookies to store data that will be used again during your next visit to a website and only that website may read such cookies.



We use only those cookies that are technical cookies which are necessary for the proper functioning of our website and the use of its features and/or services. These technical cookies are always active because they are necessary for the functioning of the website and cannot be deactivated in our systems. They are set up as a response to your actions that include a request for services, such as cookie settings or sending an email inquiry. You can set your web browser to block these cookies or send an alert about them, but in that case some parts of our website will not be functional. These cookies do not store any information that could identify you.
